

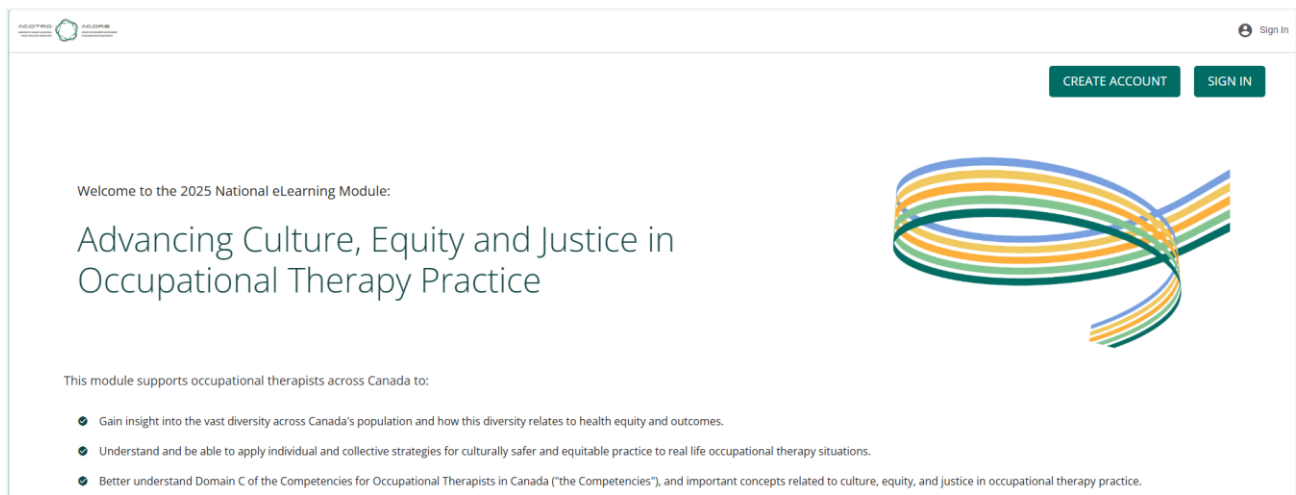

GETTING STARTED:

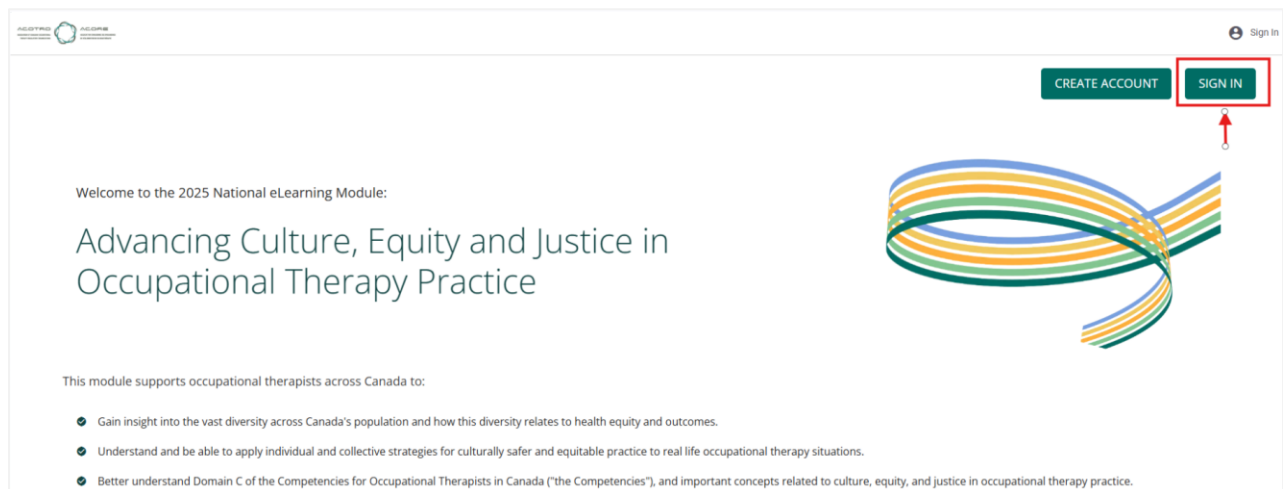

To begin, open a web browser, type the following url: <https://ot-elearning.skillbuilder.co> and click "Enter". From the home page, you will be able to sign in or, if you don't have an account, create one.

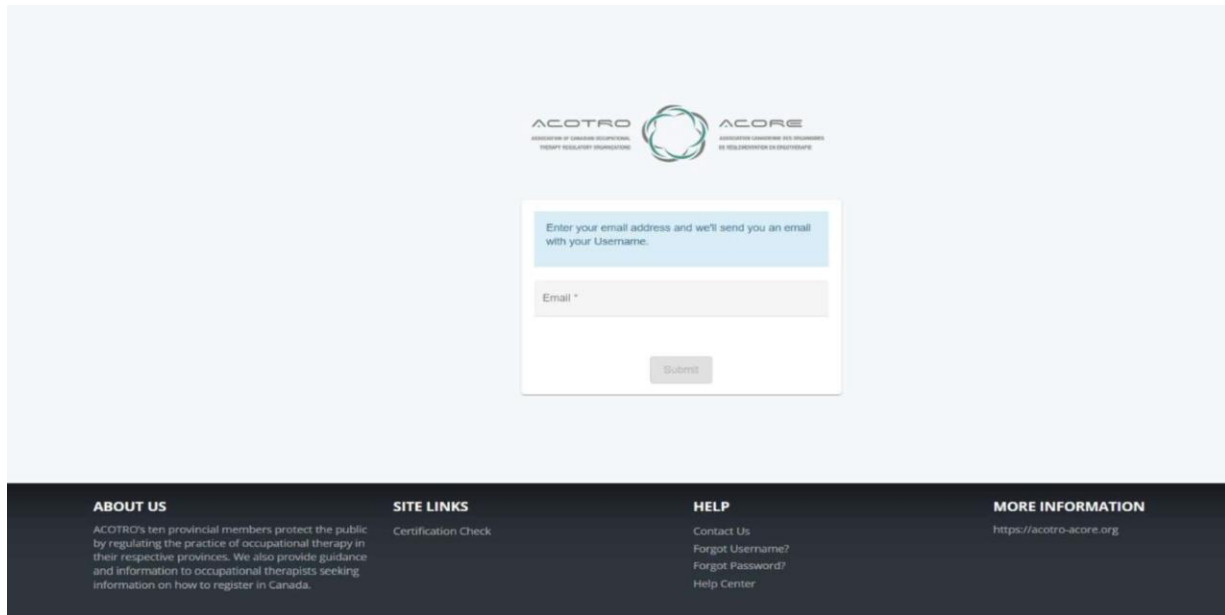

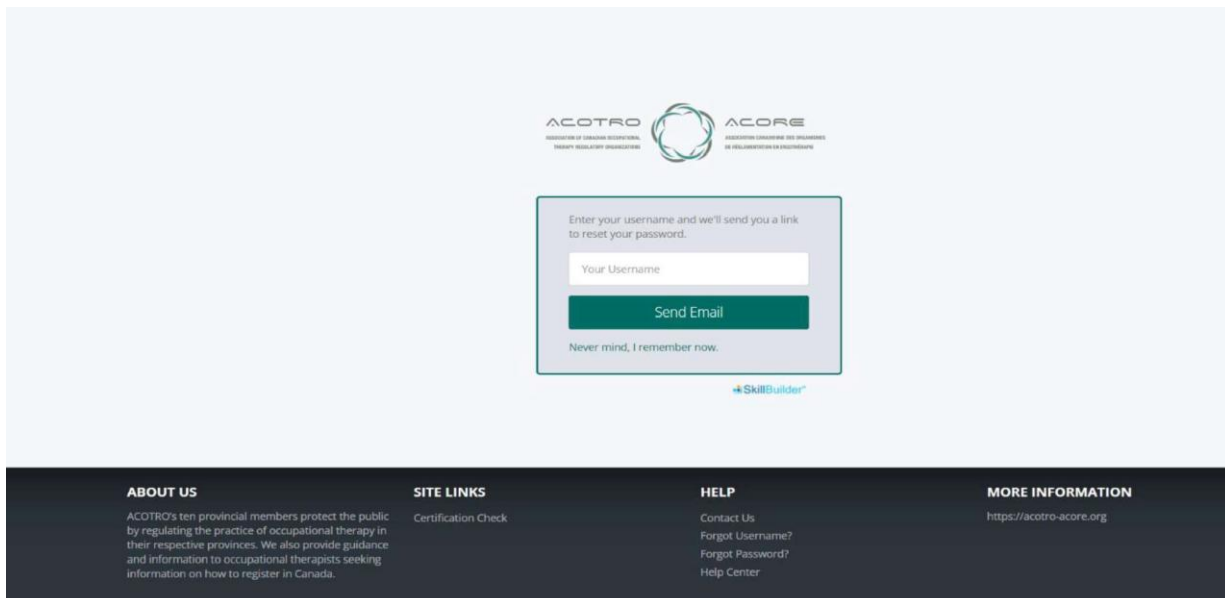

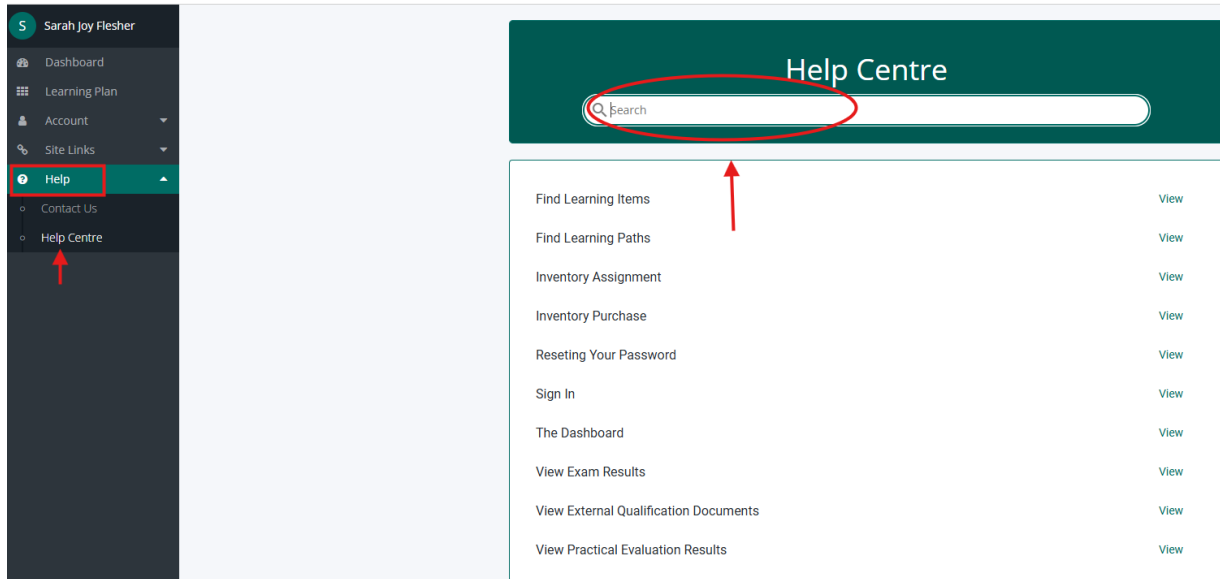

Accessing the 2025 National eLearning Module
